General Information

Institute Date and Location—The Institute will be conducted at the University Club and Alumni Center of the University of Louisville on Friday, April 24, 2009. The Club is located on the north end of Belknap Campus with easy access from I-64, I-65, and I-71, and only ten minutes from the Louisville International Airport.

CLE Credit—The Institute is seeking approval from the Kentucky Bar Association for 7.0 hours of CLE credit including two (2) hours satisfying the Kentucky ethics requirement. Participants wishing certification of their attendance for other states should submit all required forms and instructions.

Registration Fee—The registration fee is \$225. A ten percent discount will be granted to all law firms or organizations registering two or more persons. This fee includes copies of presentations, continental breakfast, lunch, refreshment breaks, and a list of all participants.

Cancellations and Refunds—Fees cannot be refunded for registrations cancelled after April 17, 2009. Substitution is allowed anytime.
