General Information

Institute Date and Location—The program will be conducted at Masterson's on Friday, April 10, 2009. The restaurant is located at 1830 S. Third Street, near the north west end of Belknap Campus with easy access from I-64, I-65, and I-71, and only ten minutes from the Louisville International Airport.

CLE Credit—The program is seeking approval from the Kentucky Bar Association for 2.0 hours of CLE credit including one (1) hour satisfying the Kentucky ethics requirement. Participants wishing certification of their attendance for other states should submit all required forms and instructions.

Registration Fee—The registration fee is \$50 plus \$15 for lunch. A ten percent discount will be granted to all law firms or organizations registering two or more persons. This fee includes copies of presentations and a list of all participants.

Cancellations and Refunds—Fees cannot be refunded for registrations cancelled after April 1, 2009. Substitution is allowed anytime.
